Description

The Stormwater Authority was created in 2021. Funding for operation, maintenance and improvement of the MS4 has historically been budgeted as part of the Borough's General Fund. However, as development progresses, flooding and stormwater quality concerns intensify, and federal and state regulations increase, a dedicated funding source became necessary for the required sustainability of the MS4.

Lennon, Smith, Souleret Engineering, Inc. conducted a Stormwater Management Fee Study to develop an equitable, fair, and reasonable MS4 user fee system that promotes that users and beneficiaries, of the Borough's MS4 pay a proportionate share of the costs of administration, operation, maintenance, repair, replacement and improvement of the MS4.

Description

The Stormwater Fund will be used in 2023 to fund expenses associated with stormwater management infrastructure improvements and compliance with the Borough's regulatory requirements imposed by the MS4 NPDES Permit issued to the Borough by PADEP.

Administration of the Borough MS4 and provision of the stormwater utility service to its users requires effort of many Borough departments and staff members, including the Borough Manager, Director of Municipal Services, Department of Public Works and administrative/billing/clerical staff.
